### NEWS LETTER 3

Dear Members,

Well the year has flown by and December is upon us with many going away. On behalf of the SAVVA committee may we wish everybody a very happy holiday season – if you are travelling please be safe on the roads.

Since my term as Chairman started in September I have sent out two newsletters and two reports that were tabled at the National Department of Transport meetings held in July and November with some reasonable results for the movement. At this point I must thank all the SAVVA Delegates who attended the meeting in April for their input as well as to the SAVVA Subcommittee: Jack Clough (KZN), Dave Alexander (Cape) and Koos De Beer (FS) for their valued support and assistance - it is really appreciated. Thanks to Jack for introducing SAVVA onto the NDoT Committee where we were able to present our concerns for comment and finally have certain proposals placed on the agenda for approval. Some of the important issues considered have been passed and should be implemented within the next six month period.

Jack Clough has decided to resign from SAVVA but has offered to act in a consultancy position as and when needed. Ken Tilley has agreed to take over the reins on behalf of KZN and will be the representative in that area for all the local clubs, Eric McQuillan is Motor Vehicle Liaison and is kept busy with the importation of vehicles to S.A. as many vehicles have to be cleared by ITAC before they will be released.

I would like to remind the Clubs to liaise with their representative in the respective areas regarding information and/or updates on legislation. If necessary you can contact me directly. All insurance matters are to be referred to David Hoff as he will be in a position to give you answers immediately in this regard.

Alex Duffey, a representative for SAVVA holds the portfolio for South Africa Heritage Resources Agency (SARHA) and attended a meeting in Cape Town to ascertain the ins and outs of the Government Organisation with regard to the regulations on the export of Motor Vehicles from S.A. This body is not just for Motor vehicles but all artifacts of historical interest to SA, e.g. Clocks, Furniture, Memorabilia etc... This meeting was extremely successful and Alex is busy compiling a report as to the outcome - it seems that SAVVA will play an important role with this Government Organisation in the future.

**A reminder that I requested that clubs submit their membership list to myself or David as we are in the process of updating the registers - to date I have only received from five clubs. Please send this information as soon as possible as the dead line is December.**

Lastly it is important that information given to David is up to date and should your delegate or the responsible person receiving your clubs information change for any reason please notify the secretary immediately. The onus is on you to keep us informed!

There was mention in the minutes of the SAVVA AGM that the Chairman's Trophy had not been returned from Jack Clough, it transpires that it had been returned but misplaced at the VVC and could not be handed over to Peter Aneck-Hahn, kindly amend your minutes accordingly and the trophy will be handed over in due course.

In my last newsletter I asked clubs to submit a list of previous D-J Riders who have participated in these event over the years but no longer ride - we require their names in order to send an invitation to attend a special function at the end of the 2011 D-J Run where we would like to celebrate their achievement in competing in this prestigious event.
